Those seeking admission under DASA scheme have to apply online, fill an online application form and make fee payment through SWIFT transfer / E-payment on or before 23:59 (IST), 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2015. Further, online application and

documents should be uploaded to DASA website through portal only. Applicants should also arrange to send SAT Subject Test scores directly from College Board, USA, to Malaviya National Institute of Technology Jaipur (*Institute*

*Code: 7664*) so as to reach DASA Office, MNIT Jaipur on or before 23:59 HRS (IST) 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2015.
